## 1 John 2:1 (KJV)

My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

Here, in the only other use of the word in the NT, it is Jesus, not the Spirit, who is described as  $\pi\alpha\rho\dot{\alpha}\kappa\lambda\eta\tau$ ος (paraklhto").
